We are writing to ask you to challenge Governor Inslee's Directive 22-13.

To our knowledge, no WA State government agency has ever attempted to use its rule-making authority to mandate a medical intervention on any group of individuals without <u>explicit</u> authorization from the state legislature. No governor has ever used a directive to order agencies to make the attempt. Why now?

It could not be because the intervention—in this case multiple and never-ending booster injections of a genetic spike protein containing or generating product—is safe, effective, or necessary for the preservation of public health, as the data and studies clearly show. In fact, the science shows the intervention has the potential to decrease both individual and public safety through mechanisms such as <u>ADE</u> (antibody dependent enhancement), <u>Original Antigenic Sin</u> (aka Imprinting), <u>Immune Tolerance</u>, as well as <u>myocarditis/pericarditis</u>, <u>blood clots</u>, <u>autoimmune disease</u>, and a host of other injuries which both the CDC and FDA listed as Adverse of Events of Special Interest prior to the release of the first shots and which are now showing as <u>massive</u> red flags in the VAERS data.

Governor Inslee's <u>Directive 22-13</u>, and his pressure upon OFM and "higher education institutions, boards and commissions, and other separately elected officials to consider similar requirements within their agencies and jurisdictions" to impose similar unethical mandates achieves:

- Violation of the human right to bodily autonomy and medical choice.
- Coercion and undue influence by the government.
- Citizens being used as test subjects for Pfizer, Moderna, and other biopharma companies which are shielded from liability yet are profiting in the billions.
- Installation of adult tracking systems.

Please stand up for the civil servants *you serve* and withdraw <u>WSR 22-14-104</u>. Without checks and balances in government, without agency heads willing to say no to unethical directives, our Republic and freedom vanish.
